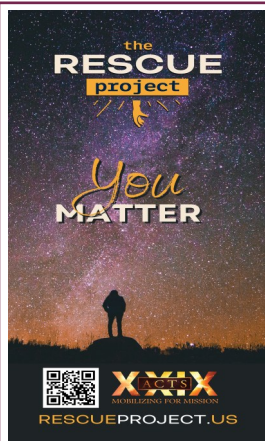

82. Why is Jesus called "Christ"?

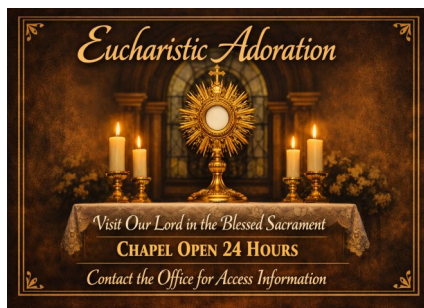
"Christ" in Greek, "Messiah" in Hebrew, means the "anointed one". Jesus is the Christ because he is consecrated by God and anointed by the Holy Spirit for his redeeming mission. He is the Messiah awaited by Israel, sent into the world by the Father. Jesus accepted the title of Messiah but he made the meaning of the term clear: "come down from heaven" (John 3:13), crucified and then risen, he is the Suffering Servant "who gives his life as a ransom for the many" (Matthew 20:28). From the name Christ comes our name of *Christian*.

Receiving Holy Communion in a Catholic Church

We welcome everyone who is visiting with us today or new to St. Luke Parish. **Be assured that that the graces of the Mass are for everyone present.** Receiving the Holy Eucharist (Communion), is only for baptized Catholics who have received the Sacrament of First Holy Communion, are prepared according to the teaching of the Catholic Church, and in a state of grace. This means Catholics should be celebrating the Sacrament of Confession regularly (*minimally once a year at Easter*) and not in the state of mortal sin.

Catholics who are not prepared and non-Catholics may approach for a blessing. Place your arms across your chest and leave them there when you approach the priest.
