PREP PARENTAL STATEMENT OF COMMITMENT (updated April 2023)

Parents are the Primary Educators of their children, especially in the Faith. The Parish Catechism Program does not take the place of parents, but rather assists them in their efforts to share the Faith with their children.

At Baptism, parents make a solemn commitment to raise their children “**in the practice of the Faith**”. Families need to actively participate in the life of the Church, especially in Sunday Mass.

Parents support the Religious Education Curriculum by participating in parent sessions and working with their child/children at home. They ensure that their child/children attend class regularly, are prepared and have done assigned work. Parents cooperate with the catechist and the pastor to promote the best possible learning experience for their child/children.

I understand that the volunteers of PREP are to be companions in assisting me in nurturing my child(ren)’s faith. I understand the following to be important and necessary to this commitment to Christ and promise to:

▪ Make ***Sundays Matter*** by:

- celebrating Mass weekly
- spending time together as a family

▪ Make ***JESUS Matter*** by:

- putting Him first in my life and that of my child(ren)
- talking to Him in Prayer (*teach and pray the traditional prayers of our Catholic faith and other forms of prayer*)
- growing in my own spiritual journey through programs offered at the Parish.

▪ Make ***PREP Class Matter*** by:

- Attending class each week (***5+ absences may require your child to remain at the same level***)
- Arriving on time for class; arriving late is disruptive to the late student and the class.
- Coming prepared (*bring the “3 B’s” - Binder, Bag, and Bible*)
- Completing assigned “God-work” at home and reviewing weekly with my child(ren)
- Encouraging my child(ren) to fully participate in learning, praying, and engaging in class activities.
- Communicating with my child(ren)’s catechists, PREP coordinator and pastor
