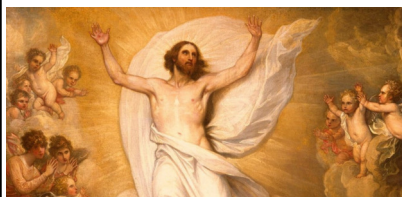
we go, beginning with our family and our parish, "living in a manner worthy of the call [we] have received."

We were honored by the presence of Archbishop J. Michael Miller who concelebrated the Spanish Holy Mass with Father Richard Zannotti. After mass, Archbishop Miller, Father Richard, the coordinator of the Seasonal Farm Workers Ministry in Vancouver, and our very own Father Edwin joined in the chile dinner prepared by the volunteers at the Parish Family Centre. His Grace enjoyed mingling and breaking bread with our migrant brothers in Christ. The dinner was "muy delicioso" was the main comment!

We bade farewell to Sister Karina, a member of the Theresian Carmelite Missionaries who is leaving Vancouver for her new pastoral assignment. She is our main connection to our migrant workers as she works with the Seasonal Farm Workers from Guatemala and Mexico in the Lower Mainland.

Please join us every 4th Sunday of the month from April to October as we reach out to our migrant brothers in Christ and welcome them to our church community. We start with the Spanish mass at 3PM followed by a simple reception and sharing at the Parish Family Centre.

Journey with Christ

Learn what prayer is and how it can enrich your spiritual life as we journey each week through the Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church's section on Prayer.

559. In the Church are there different ways of praying?

In the Church there are various ways of praying that are tied to different historical, social and cultural contexts. The Magisterium of the Church has the task of discerning the fidelity of these ways of praying to the tradition of apostolic faith. It is for pastors and catechists to explain their meaning which is always related to Jesus Christ.

560. What is the way of our prayer?

The way of our prayer is Christ because prayer is directed to God our Father but reaches him only if we pray – at least implicitly – in the name of Jesus. His humanity is in effect the only way by which the Holy Spirit teaches us to pray to our Father. Therefore liturgical prayers conclude with the formula: "Through our Lord Jesus Christ."
